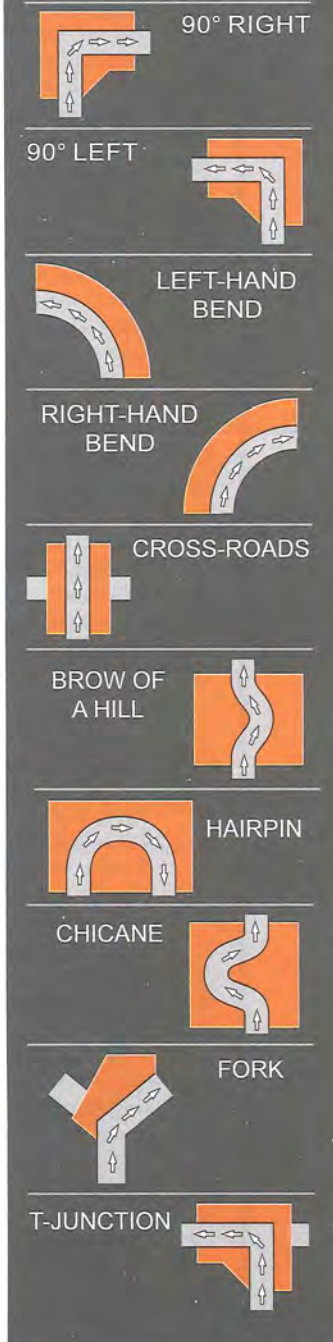

The National Championship Rally starts first and the first car leaves the SOUTHERN CROSS HOTEL, High St Dunedin at 7.30am. The Allcomers Rally will follow, then the Classics. Each car will arrive 20 minutes early and be displayed at the start.

**Special Stage 1 – Mitchell Mackersy Lawyers Whare Flat. 12.9km, starts 7.55am**  
Best viewing midstage, on the road to the Pineapple Track carpark.

**Special Stage 2 – Dunedin Automotive Akatore. 32.2km, 9.05am**  
Best viewing midstage from Waihola - Taieri Mouth Rd, or above finish line if in place 30 minutes before first car.

**Special Stage 3 – Vision Antenna Coal Gully Rd. 6.4km, 9.40am**  
Only viewing from start and finish.

**Pitstop Service A at Waihola.**  
First car arrives at 10.05am and stays 25 minutes.

**Special Stage 4 – NJL Builders Kuri Bush. 15.1km, 11.00am**  
Best viewing midstage at Christies Gully Rd intersection.

**Special Stage 5 – Custom Signs McIntosh Rd. 8.1km, 11.25am**  
Best viewing midstage from Scroggs Hill Rd, prime viewing with commentary

**Pitstop Service B at Waihola.**  
First car arrives at 11.50am and stays 30 minutes.

**Special Stage 6 – Oakley Gray Architects Waipori Gorge. 13.0km, 12.45pm.**  
Best viewing from start, but a reasonably long walk. Be in place 30 minutes before first car.

**Special Stage 7 – Adams Plumbing Glenburnie 1. 42.3km, 1.10pm.**  
Best viewing midstage at Waihola Hill Rd.

**Pitstop Service C at Fryatt St, Dunedin.**  
First car arrives at 2.30pm and stays 20 minutes.

**Special Stage 8 – More FM Tarmac Superstage. 2.1km, 3.00pm**

First car arrives at 9.10am and stays 35 minutes.

**Special Stage 11 Mosgiel Kitchens Hartfield. 18.4km, 10.05am**  
Best viewing from finish

**Special Stage 12 – O'Neill Devereux Longdale. 12.6km, 10.30am**  
Best viewing from start and finish, but not wonderful.

**Special Stage 13 – Kennys Tyres Moonlight 2. 10.8km, 11.10am.**  
Best viewing from last intersection midstage or finish if in place 30 minutes before first car.

**Pitstop Service E at Middlemarch.**  
First car arrives at 11.35am and stays 30 minutes.

**Special Stage 14 – Central Radio Services Glenburnie 2. 42.3km, 1.10pm.**  
Best viewing midstage at Waihola Hill Rd, prime viewing with commentary

**Finish Ceremony. Octagon, 2.30pm**  
City Centre finish ramp and champagne ceremony.
