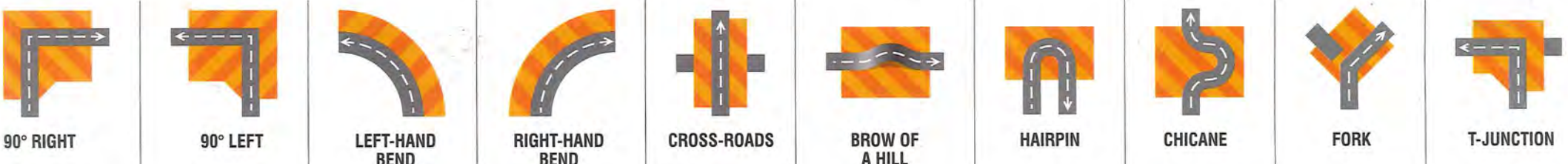

Pitstop Service F at Waiholo

First car arrives at 10.15am and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 14 – Oakley Gray Architects Kuri Bush. 15.11km, 11.00am

Best viewing midstage at from south end of Christies Gully Rd intersection.

Special Stage 15 – Dunlop Tyres McIntosh Rd. 8.12km, 11.30am

Best viewing midstage at Scroggs Hill Rd intersection.

Service G at Waiholo

First car arrives at 11.55am and stays 30 minutes.

Special Stage 16 – Team Talk Berwick. 44.15km, starts 12.55pm.

Best viewing at intersection midstage above Doon Flat Rd, or in from start (a bit of a walk).

Special Stage 17 – O'Neill Devereux Waipori Gorge. 12.76km, 1.50pm.

Best viewing from finish, but a reasonably long walk. 2.5km to bridge! Be in place 30 minutes before first car.

Finish Ceremony. Dunedin's Historic Railway Station, 3.10pm

Downtown finish ramp and champagne ceremony.
