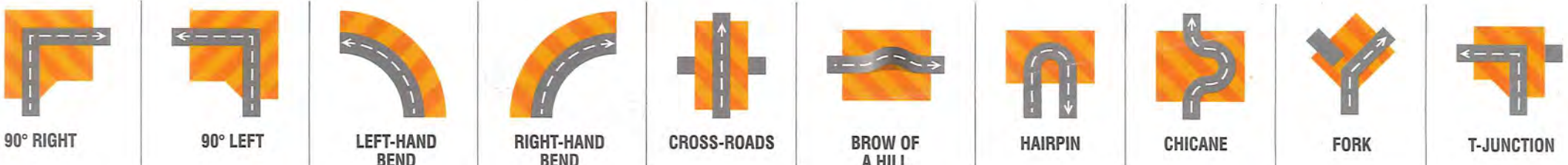

First car arrives at 8.50am and stays 30 minutes.

**Special Stage 11 – AA Auto Service and Repair Hartfield. 19.00km, 9.40am**  
Best viewing from start or finish.

**Special Stage 12 – The Terrace Sports Bar Longdale. 12.63km, 10.05am.**  
Best viewing from start or finish if in place 30 minutes before first car.

**Special Stage 13 – Specialised Structures Moonlight 2. 10.73km, starts 10.45am.**  
Best viewing if drive up Moonlight Rd from Middlemarch end to intersection with Bald Hill Rd. Prime viewing spot, with commentary.

**Pitstop Service G at Middlemarch**  
First car arrives at 11.10am and stays 30 minutes.

**Special Stage 14 – Oakley Gray Architects Waipori Gorge. 12.66km, 12.50pm.**  
Best viewing from start, but a reasonably long walk. 2.5km to bridge! Be in place 30 minutes before first car.

**Special Stage 15 – NJL Builders Kuri Bush. 15.05km, 1.45pm**  
Best viewing midstage at Christies Gully Rd intersection.

**Special Stage 16 – Ritchies Whare Flat Powerstage. 10.94km, starts 2.20pm**  
Best viewing midstage, on the road to the Pineapple Track carpark, or at finish.

**Fulton Hogan Finish Ceremony. Railway Station, 3.20pm**  
City Centre finish ramp and champagne ceremony.
